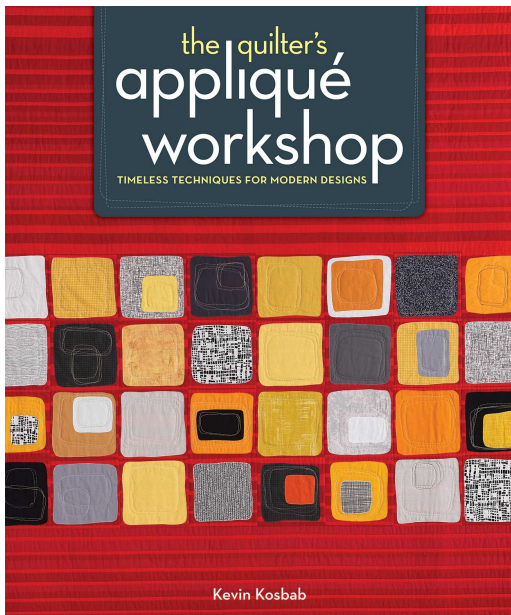


THE QUILTER'S APPLIQUÉ WORKSHOP **Timeless Techniques for Modern Designs**

Full of detailed instructions, tips, illustrations and twelve quilted home décor projects, ***The Quilter's Appliqué Workshop*** shows sewists how fun and easy it is to do appliqué—whether as the focus of projects or as an occasional embellishment.

“Appliqué isn’t a difficult process. Anyone can do it with practice,” encourages Kevin. ***The Quilter's Appliqué Workshop*** gives readers the confidence and tools they need to mix and match techniques to create any design they can imagine. Divided into three sections, ***The Quilter's Appliqué Workshop*** teaches readers everything they need to know about three main categories of appliqué—raw-edge, prepared-edge and needle-turn, and where appropriate, discusses both hand- and machine-sewing approaches. The twelve home décor projects, complete with full-size patterns, include bed and wall quilts, table runners/toppers, pillows and more. The projects illustrate each technique and several designs explore

more specialized appliqué styles, such as *broderie perse*, felt appliqué and bias tape appliqué, while improvisational and freeform approaches to appliqué are considered throughout.

In addition to being the most comprehensive appliqué book for quilting, ***The Quilter's Appliqué Workshop*** showcases Kevin’s love for strong colors, bold graphics and mid-century modern design, as well as his fresh, modern take on quilting and appliqué. Established quilters wanting to add appliqué to their repertoire, sewists looking for colorful, contemporary designs, as well as home décor sewists who want to create projects to brighten their homes will all benefit from Kevin’s expertise and sense of style.
